



Understanding Normal Movement *Normal Movement Workshop (NMW) for Paediatric Therapists*

Course Description:

This two-day course is designed to introduce participants to the concept of movement analysis in the assessment and treatment of children with neurodevelopmental disorders. Participants will be able to describe key components relating to the analysis of postures and movement sequences and learn how to facilitate movement with the opportunity to practice handling skills. This is a practical course with the focus on therapists developing their skills of observation of posture and movement, with the practice of facilitation of normal movement. The workshop forms one of several modules that contribute to gaining certification on the NZBA Modular Paediatric Foundation Course.



Course Aims:

- To present a framework for systematic analysis of typical patterns of posture and movement and recognise the variability of these.
- To demonstrate how course participants can use their hands, body and voice to facilitate another individual to move and recognise what resultant changes have occurred.

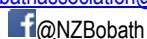
Refund Policy
